



## **“Christ the Creator”**

**Start with a few questions to get everyone talking.**

**Choose questions that will work well with your group or family.**

1. Read Romans 7:24. Given today's message why does Paul say he has a body of death?
2. How then are we rescued from this body of death? See Ephesians 3:16-19.
3. Read Romans 8:6-11. We live in tension between Law and Gospel. What is the result if we measure our lives according to the Law? What is the result if we measure our lives according to the Gospel?
4. Read Job 19:25-27. What promise is made for the resurrection of the body?

**To introduce some different perspectives into the conversation, consider reading one of these verses together.**

Romans 7:24, Ephesians 3:16-19, Romans 8: 6-11,  
Job 19: 25-27, Romans 7:25b, Philippians 3:12-14

**End each week with a challenge to take action. Lead your group to help each person identify their next steps.**

In Romans 7:25b, Paul gives a realistic description of himself and every Christian. What does this verse say about the possibility of our perfect sanctification (holy living) here on earth? For help see Philippians 3:12-14.
