



The Best of Romans – Week 3 “United in Death”

Start with a few questions to get everyone talking. Choose questions that will work well with your group or family.

1. Perhaps the most profound question in all scripture is Romans 6:1. Its answer is found in Romans 6:2. Where in your life are you glad that grace abounds? Be specific and honest with your answer.
2. As we celebrate 500 years since the Reformation, the method and teachings on baptism have been debated as far back as Luther and Zwingli. How might Romans 6:3-4 give you new insight to the power and presence of baptism? Read Galatians 3:27 of this significance.
3. What glory awaits us as we are “united in death?” Read Revelation 21:4. Of the list given in this Scripture reading what is the most significant for you? How about Romans 8:18?

To introduce some different perspectives into the conversation, consider reading one of these verses together.

Galatians 3:27, Revelation 21:4, Romans 8:18,
1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

End each week with a challenge to take action. Lead your group to help each person identify their next steps.

1. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18. How will we be united with Christ? What do these verses say about death?
