3. A turning point happens in vs. 4. There is a "Yes, but" statement that we all need to hear. What compelled God to do something to pull us from the certain death because of our sin?
4. What did he do for you (vs. 5 & 6)? How much did you contribute to this?
5. So now what? What does vs. 10 mean for your life?
